A Resolution Opposing a Payroll Tax on Employers

Whereas small companies with fewer than 50 employees would pay the bulk of a \$1.2 billion payroll tax being pushed by Governor Blagojevich and

Whereas, that could drive those small companies out of business, putting their employees out of work and thereby raising costs to consumers and

Whereas, the proposed 3% payroll tax expected to bring in \$1.2 billion is paid by less than 16,000 businesses

Now therefore, be it resolved by NIBAC (Northern Illinois Business Advocacy Coalition), and the President of NIBAC to call upon the Illinois General Assembly to consider a more equitable way of funding the Governor's Universal Health Care plan that could be spread across all Illinois residents.
